What Is Winterim?

Winterim at Lancaster Bible College is made up of an eight day semester with class sessions meeting for five hours a day. The Winterim term is part of the regular academic program and all courses earn credit toward the various degree programs of the College. The complete curriculum of the College is found in the LBC catalog.
